**Re: Wireless Services at the Lester B. Pearson International Airport**

Thank you for your call on Tuesday, June 25 in response to the fax sent earlier the same day by the Wireless Carriers requesting continued negotiation with GTAA. Response to your call requires agreement from four carriers. Appropriate communication among all parties is now complicated by timing, logistics and the approaching holiday weekend.

The Carriers ask that:

1. The conditions under which the GTAA will resume negotiations be put in writing; and
2. Given that we are less than three days away from the holiday weekend on which the current deadline falls, the GTAA confirm in writing that wireless equipment on GTAA property will not be disconnected until the Carriers receive the conditions and can respond to them, assuming that this is done in a timely manner.
