
**RE: Objection to SOCAN Tariff 24, 2006 – Ringtones and Ringbacks**

The Canadian Wireless Telecommunications Association (“CWTA”) hereby gives notice that it objects to proposed Tariff 24 contained in the Statement of Proposed Royalties to be Collected by SOCAN for the Public Performance or the Communication to the Public by Telecommunication, in Canada, of Musical or Dramatic-Musical Works for the Year 2007 which was published by the Copyright Board in the Supplement to the Canada Gazette, Part I, May 20, 2006.

CWTA is a trade association representing cellular, PCS, messaging, mobile radio, fixed wireless and mobile satellite carriers as well as companies that develop and produce products and services for the industry.

CWTA relies on its past objections for the proposed tariff for 2006 and extends those objections to the ringtone portion as well as the new ringback portion of the proposed tariff for 2006.
